Name of Position and Team/Task Force

Seasonal Worship Team

Responsibilities

Working together with pastors and other church staff in a coordinated effort of worship planning, making recommendations, and implementation and evaluation of worship.

Qualifications

1. Provide a continuity and overall sense of direction to worship
2. Foster a seasonal tie for worship for an entire season
 - January 1 – planning starts for Pentecost (Summer)
 - April 1 – planning starts for Pentecost (Fall)
 - July 1 – planning starts for Advent/Christmas/Epiphany – season starts first Sunday in Advent
 - October 1 – planning starts for Lent/Easter – season starts Ash Wednesday
3. Create a sense of renewal
4. Seeks ways for growth in the worship experience
5. Ultimately, the work of the Seasonal Worship Teams will result in:
 - An increased number of people attending worship on a regular basis
 - The congregation is able to fulfill its mission as outlined in the Mission Statement

Length of Commitment

1. New members are encouraged to join the work of the Team when planning for the next seasonal block begins. Existing members may exit the Team after three-month liturgical block.
2. Minimum commitment to serve on the Team is nine months.
3. It is estimated that approx. 60% of the work for a season will be done before the start of the season, approx. 30% during and approx. 10% at the conclusion of the season.
